Delegated Authority and Purpose	Senate is the academic governing body of BU and is responsible to the Vice-Chancellor and the University Board for monitoring and advising on the academic work of the University.		
Main responsibilities	Subject to the provisions of the Articles of Government for BU Senate shall be responsible for:		
	 General matters relating to research, scholarship, teaching and programmes at the University, including the criteria for the admission of students; The appointment and removal of internal and external examiners (delegated to Academic Standards & Education Committee); Policies and procedures for assessment and examination of the academic performance of students; The content of the curriculum; Academic standards and quality and the validation and review of programmes; The procedures for the awards of qualifications and honorary academic titles; Confirmation of awards made by undergraduate and postgraduate Boards of Examiners and by Research Examinations Teams (the Vice-Chancellor on behalf of Senate); The procedures for the expulsion of students for academic reasons; Considering both the development of the academic activities of the University and the resources needed to support them and for advising the Vice-Chancellor and the University Board thereon; Advising on such other matters as the University Board or the Vice-Chancellor may refer to Senate
