



Building a Better Bournemouth

THE BOROUGH OF BOURNEMOUTH (Holdenhurst Road)(Public Utility Connection) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2014

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bournemouth Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004, has made the above Order.

The effect of the order will be:

To prohibit all traffic proceeding on Holdenhurst Road (Northbound Lane) from The Lansdowne Roundabout to Bournemouth Station Roundabout because works are to be executed for the purpose of Public Utility Connection.

Watkin Jones Group will carry out the works.

The diversion for vehicles affected by this prohibition will be via Christchurch Road and St Swithun's Road.

Access to properties will be maintained commensurate with the progress of the works and site safety.

The restrictions above will be operative from 24 November 2014 until 07 December 2014.

If the works are not completed by 07 December 2014 the Order may be extended by the Council to a total period not exceeding eighteen months.

If the works are not completed within eighteen months (i.e. by 23 May 2016) the Order could be further extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.

The Council regrets any inconvenience to the public caused by this temporary prohibition.
