Selecting your units

- Students' programme and units will be in line with our partnership agreement.
- At BU, you will study 3 units each Semester. Each unit is worth 10 ECTS or 20 BU CATS
- It is not possible to select units from across different programme, levels or years. You must select units from the same programme, level and year.
- Compulsory units must be studied and, where you have a choice of additional units these are clearly marked as 'Optional Units'.
- Optional units are offered subject to viability and therefore may not run.
- You may be asked to include an alternative unit. This will be a back up unit if one of your unit choices is not available. Please make sure that any alternative unit/s are clearly marked as an alternative on your learning agreement.
- Units are only taught once in an academic year, so you can only select units that are listed for the semester that you are applying to study at BU.
- We endeavour to accommodate all unit choices subject to timetabling restrictions.
