<b>Quick-Facts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EDHEC Business School was founded in the early 20th century by industrialists in northern France with its mission to place business at the service of society.</li> <li>• EDHEC ranks among <b>the top 10 business schools in Europe</b>, recognised for its internationalised outlook and approach.</li> <li>• EDHEC is also a member of the select category of business schools worldwide (fewer than 1%) to be triple accredited by AACSB, EQUIS and AMBA.</li> <li>• 8600 students study at EDHEC with 35% being foreign students from over 110 nationalities.</li> <li>• EDHEC is spread out across two main campuses in France – Lille in northern France and Nice in south of France.</li> </ul>

Also ensure that you are only booking accommodation in Bournemouth for the semester that you will be studying at BU.</b></p>
<p><b>Health Insurance</b></p>	<p>Exchange students are obliged to arrange for sufficient health insurance coverage during their study period.</p> <p>You can apply for an <a href="#">EHIC/GHIC card</a> which enables you to obtain medical assistance for free when abroad. If you are an EU passport holder you will be able to use your EHIC card when travelling to an EU country. If you are a UK passport holder and/or do not have an EU passport, please read the information about how to apply for a <a href="#">UK GHIC card</a>. As a BU student, you can apply for your EHIC/GHIC card using the <a href="#">BU Letter Request Form</a>.</p> <p>Please note that some non-European partners request that incoming students purchase additional health insurance to comply with their immigration and institutional requirements.</p> <p>You can find further information on the <a href="#">practical arrangements</a> webpage.</p>
<p><b>Travel Insurance</b></p>	<p>BU offers a comprehensive <a href="#">BU travel cover</a> to all outgoing students. after reviewing BU's travel cover, and depending on personal considerations or specific health issues, some students might decide to purchase an additional insurance policy to top-up what is available.</p> <p><b>Please note that BU Travel Cover is updated every August.</b></p>
<p><b>Visas &amp; Permits</b></p>	<p>When travelling to France you must consider what document(s) you will need to enter the country and commence your studies or research at EDHEC. This will depend on the country you are travelling from, your home citizenship, the length of your stay in France, and the purpose of your stay in France amongst other criteria.</p> <p><b>Please make sure to understand what is needed and secure this in time before you travel and that you have an up-to-date passport that expires no earlier than 6 months after you intend to return.</b></p>

	<p>All non-European students who will be studying in France longer than three months must apply for a student visa – and certain nationalities require visas even for short stays. Check the <a href="#">France Visa website</a> as a start, then apply at your nearest French consulate or embassy no later than three months before your prospective arrival date.</p> <p>For detailed information and guidelines, particularly for regulations concerning your country of origin, please visit the Campus France website, or visit the respective French embassy or consulate website. The amount of grant depends on your household income, and covers reasonable costs incurred on travel expenses during an academic year.
