If you are a UK passport holder and/or do not have an EU passport, please read the information about how to apply for a <u>UK GHIC card</u> . As a BU student, you can apply for your EHIC/GHIC card using the <u>BU Letter Request Form</u> .

	Please make sure to understand what is needed and secure this in time before you travel and that you have an up-to-date passport that expires no earlier than 6 months after you intend to return. Exchange students with a non-EEA nationality will receive an information package that includes the application form and the list of attachments to add to the resident permit application after the course application deadlines to start the process through the Italian Embassy.
