


# Sustainable Travel Hierarchy



## Does the meeting need to take place face to face?

Can you attend the meeting virtually or can it be achieved over the phone.

### Is the meeting close enough to walk or cycle to?

If you are cycling don't forget you can claim 15p per mile for business travel.
